***Hanover, NH – Position 1 (VISTA for Local Service)***

Dartmouth Community Services seeks a VISTA who is an organized, pro-active, energetic leader, with three main areas of responsibility. First, the VISTA will advise dynamic student leaders in a portfolio of varied child-mentoring projects such as Big Brother- Sister, BookBuddies, DREAM Haven homeless shelter Homework Club and others.
