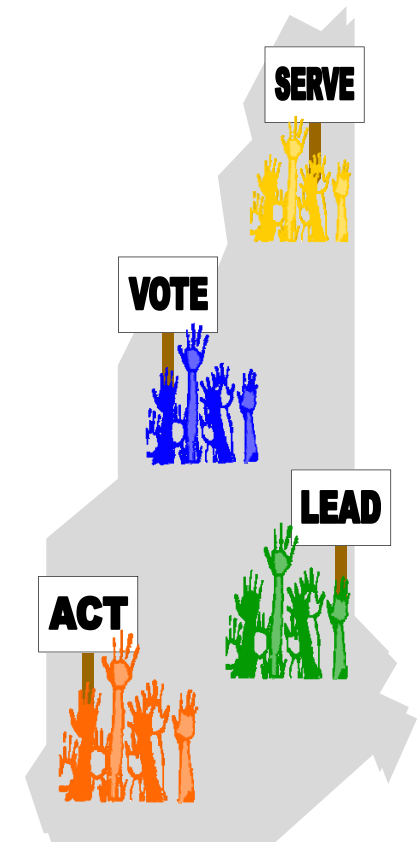

4. Will work with their college or university's Community Service Director to plan and lead a service project on campus. Community Service Directors will sign-off on students' Service Project Completion Form.
