Monadnock Bible Conference – Launch Point Franklin Pierce University

Launch Point, a program started by the Monadnock Bible Conference to support area youth, has been a community partner since the Fall of 2016 when it stepped in to replace the Jaffrey After School Program. Franklin Pierce students have been engaged with after school support and co-curricular programs for local youth for over twenty years. Launch Point, currently serves 44 youth from Kindergarten through 8th Grade. Nearly 20 Franklin Pierce students volunteer an afternoon each week, helping to provide a safe and supportive learning environment for the area youth. Student volunteers actively engage and connect with the youth through cooking classes, crafts, outdoor activities and swimming, as well as academic supports. Launch Point brings together a diverse collection of area leaders and volunteers to support the youth. The active involvement of Franklin Pierce students aids in the academic ambitions and growth of these youth as they connect with one another in small groups. This vital program supports a healthy and safe learning environment for the area youth and families.
