Big Brothers Big Sisters has been the premiere one-to-one mentoring service in the Granite State since 1966. 13 UNH students currently volunteer as part of BBBS' site-based mentoring program, working with Littles ranging from 6 to 11 years old at Mast Way Elementary School, Oyster River Middle School, and Garrison Elementary School. Matches meet once a week during lunchtime or after school and engage in activities that encourage the child's academic and personal development. Bigs and Littles spend quality time talking, reading, and playing on the playground. The Littles will also be coming to campus in April for UNH Day. They will learn about the life of a UNH student. This program opens the Littles to new experiences and empowers them to dream big! It also has an impact on the UNH volunteers, who are able to use this experience to develop their communication, responsibility, and civic engagement skills.
