Concord, NH, May 25, 2021—As part of its mission to support the development of resilient, thriving communities, the Lincoln Financial Foundation will continue its grant funding for one of New Hampshire's most well-established AmeriCorps VISTA programs. Campus Compact for New Hampshire (CCNH), which administers the program, places VISTAs in communities throughout New Hampshire to help low-income students prepare for success in school, college, and careers.

AmeriCorps VISTA is a federal program that supports volunteers working to combat poverty. CCNH’s VISTA program focuses on expanding education access and success and improving workforce readiness among low-income and first-generation students. CCNH VISTAs provide outreach, tutoring, mentoring, and resources to help students advance in school and understand their postsecondary options.

The Lincoln Financial Foundation has supported CCNH’s VISTA program for the past eight years. This long-term support has allowed the creation of structures to ensure that VISTAs both get and give maximum value through the program, says CCNH Executive Director Debby Scire.

“VISTAs serve a one-year term, so these structures are essential for building on the prior year’s work,” Scire notes. “The Lincoln Financial Foundation’s support has led to a cycle of success. In addition to providing direct aid to thousands of students, our VISTAs are creating new systems and outreach channels, which are making a lasting difference in their communities.”
